I really feel the "4's" need to feel involved early on.

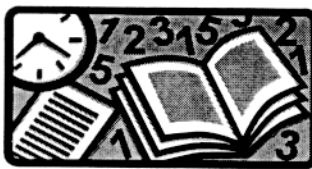
